Implementation of Biodiversity Act 10 of 2004, Threatened and Protected Species Regulations by the Free State Department of Tourism, Environmental & Economic Affairs and other related matters.

The Free State Province is presently fully implementing the TOPS regulations as from the 1st February 2008.

The implementation process works as follows:

1. Predator Breeders and Hunters.

- ❖ All large predator breeders have to re register, after registration the owner will receive a registration certificate and a standing permit, this has to be done by the end of July 2008, if breeder is not registered no permits will be issued unless the registration process has been completed.
- ❖ No predator breeder may breed and hunt on the same facility.
- ❖ All listed large predators have to be micro chipped.
- ❖ All predators to be hunted have to be chipped and released in the presence of an official from this Department.
- ❖ No predator may be hunted without a permit and an official in attendance.

2. Rhino owners and hunting.

- ❖ No rhino may be hunted without a permit issued by this Department.
- ❖ An official from this Department will be in attendance at all rhino hunts.
- ❖ No CITES permits will be issued unless a permit was issued for the hunt of the rhino and unless the rhino products to be exported were handed in at a registered taxidermist.
- ❖ All farmers in possession of rhino on their property have to register as game farmers.

3. General.

- ❖ The hunting of any TOS listed or ordinance listed species requires a permit.
- ❖ In the case of a farmer wanting to hunt black wildebeest he applies for a one off permit for all animals he wants to hunt through the year, if he has a fencing certificate he can hunt throughout the year with mentioned permit if he has no certificate he must adhere to the hunting seasons.
- ❖ The above point is only applicable to black wildebeest. For the rest of the species he has to register as a game farm and receive a standing permit.
- ❖ All persons having rhino, elephant or any product of a TOPS species in his possession has to apply for a possession permit.
